ORDER

(Matter heard through hybrid mode)

The matter is posted for disposal of Form PV-5 dated 22nd August, 2024, filed by the Opponent for extending time by one day to take on record the Final Opposition filed on 6th August, 2024.

The counter-statement in the instant matter was served to the Opponent on 5th July, 2024. Accordingly, as per Rule 31(6) of PPVFR Rules, 2003, the Opponent should have filed Final Opposition within 30 days (i.e., 4th August, 2024 but since 4th August, 2024 is a Sunday the date is taken as 5th August, 2024) from the date of receipt of counter statement on 5th July, 2024. The Opponent has sent the Final Opposition by email on 5th August, 2024 without digital signature and the hard copy of the Final Opposition was filed on 6th August, 2024



with one day delay. The Opponent has vide PV-5 requested to condone the one day delay.

Applicant has fairly conveyed that they have no objection for granting of extension of one day time to take on record the final opposition.

Accordingly, the PV-5 filed by the Opponent is allowed and Final Opposition filed on 6th August, 2024 is taken on record by condoning the one day delay.
